I bequeath to my daughter Sarah Jane
Burrman wife of John A Burrman the sum
of one hundred Dollars

I release and forgive to my sons William
McKeen and James McKeen or to their or
either of their Representatives if they or
either of them should die in my
life time every sum of money with the
interest thereon which may be owing
from them or either of them to me at
the time of my decease, and I direct
that any note or notes bond or bonds
or other Obligations or securities for
the same shall be released or given
up to the said William McKeen and
James McKeen respectively or to their
or either of their Representatives

I bequeath all the residue of my
estate and effects both real and personal
to my son Daniel Hugh McKean and
my daughters Jessie Elizabeth McKean
and Prudence McKean to be divided
equally among the three of them the one
and share alike

I do hereby and appoint my son
Daniel Hugh McKean George R. (Chalston
& Peter) Bank Manager to be the
executors of this my last will and testament

I do witness hereby that the said Daniel
