

In the name of God Amen; I Edward
McLean of Mount Thom in the County of Pictou,
and Province of Nova Scotia Farmer, taking into
consideration the uncertainty of this mortal life, Do
make and publish this my last Will and testament
in manner and form following, that is to say—

First I give and bequeath to my William
all the farm on which I at present reside consisting
of fifty acres more or less, together with all and singular
the premises and appurtenances to the said farm
belonging or in any wise appertaining, and also
all the stock farming implements and household
furniture and money, that I may have in my possession
at the date of my decease,

Secondly, I hereby also direct that my
said son William shall provide out of the said
property a good and comfortable living for his Aunt
Eleanor Reid McLean during the term of her natural
life, the said maintenance to be such as shall meet
with the approval of the executors hereinafter to be nominated,

Thirdly, I hereby direct that my son William
shall pay to his sister Mrs John Ingram the sum
of ten dollars at a reasonable time after my decease,

Fourthly, I also direct that my son William shall
pay to each of my two sons James B, and John B, the
sum of one dollar,

Fifthly, I also direct that my son William shall
pay out of the aforesaid property all my lawful debts,
testamentary and funeral expenses,

Lastly, I hereby nominate and appoint
Thomas Proudfoot, and John Proudfoot, West River,
in the County of Pictou, Farmers, Executors of this my
last Will and Testament, revoking all former wills
and Testaments by me heretofore made.

ninth day of October in the year of our Lord, one
Thousand eight hundred and seventy four.
