on the North west Corner of the said lot of land
and running thence South fifty one degrees and
thirty minutes West three chains and sixty
links, thence South thirty four degrees and
thirty minutes East four chains and thirty
two links, thence North fifty six degrees and
thirty minutes East three chains and sixty
links, thence North forty two degrees West, four
chains and thirty two links to the place of
beginning.

To John David M. Lean they apportioned


