declare this to be my last will

heretofore made, and as to my
worldly estate and all the

and possessed or to which I shall
be entitled at the time of my
decease I devise bequeath and
dispose thereof in the manner
following to wit:

My will is that all my just
debts and several expenses shall
by my executors hereinafter
named be paid out of my estate
as soon after my decease as
shall by them be found convenient

I give devise and bequeath to my
wife Mary Ann McLeod all my
real and personal property to have
and to hold in fee simple to her and
her executors, administrators and
assigns forever, providing she
maintain a widow for the
children until they are of age
but if she marries again and
fails to provide a home for the
children it will go to my son
Solon McLeod on condition that
he maintain a widow for the

Children until they are of age

I do execute and appoint my
wife Margaret the ^{elder} and John
W. Tucker to be the executors of
this my last will and Testament
