I Donald McLeod of Mount Ephraim in the County of Pictou Farmer, being at present in good health and sound mind and memory thanks be given to God. Knowing that it is appointed to all men to die, do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament.

First of all I give and recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it and my body to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian manner at the discretion of my executors herein named. assured that at the general Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the Almighty power of God.

And as regards such worldly estate as it hath pleased God to give me, I give and dispose in the following manner.

Firstly. I order that all my just debts and funeral expenses to be fully paid, and secondly I give and bequeath to my nephew Robert McLeod of Mount Ephraim Farmer, fifty seven acres of land on the north west side of my lot of land being one half of my farm containing 11 1/4 acres more or less. And thirdly I give and bequeath to Nephew Hugh McLeod of Mount Ephraim Farmer, the remaining fifty seven acres of my farm on Mount Ephraim. And fourthly I appoint and ordain Robert McLeod and Hugh McLeod my Nephews of Mount Ephraim Farmers, to be my executors of this my last Will and Testament, revoking all former Wills ratifying and confirming this and no other.
