I hereby dispose of as follows

I hereby desire my executors
hereinafter appointed as aforesaid

personal and mixed (except such
articles as I have herein specified
and devised) at the most advantageous
time and in the most advantageous
way for my legacies. The proceeds
of such sale and disposition I hereby
give devise and bequeath as follows

Nineteen Two hundred Dollars
- 2 I hereby give and devise to
Mrs Frank Kerr wife of Frank
Kerr Sawyer one hundred Dollars
also my 50 wheel and chain

- 3 I give and devise to Isabella Curry my Cousin Twenty five dollars
- 4 I give and devise to Isabella Ross my niece fifty Dollars
- 5 I give and devise to William Ross Pleasant Valley forty Dollars for the redeeming the debt of Mr Gaudoch Church House
- 6 I give and devise to my friend Will Ross of Pleasant Valley twenty Dollars
- 7 I give and devise to my friend Wm H. Ray Pleasant Valley Twenty dollars
- 8 I give and devise to my friend Angus McKee Pleasant Valley Twenty dollars
- 9 I give and devise to my friend George Ross Twenty dollars and my part of stock of clothes
- 10 I give and devise to my friend Joseph McKee wife of Alexander McKee Twenty dollars
- 11 I give and devise to Wm McKee the son of my friend twenty dollars
- 12 I hereby order that after the above sums of moneys is paid over to the judges hands should there be any balance left I hereby devise the same to Mrs Wm Ross and Mrs Janet Ross above mentioned equally share and share alike
- 13 I shoud there not be a sufficient sum to give each half the sum I do appoint that the same shall be divided in that proportion to their share

I hereby nominate and appoint my
two friends William Ross of Pleasant
Talley & Aaron and Wm F Oliver
of Newwith Merchants Executors of
this my last will
