I hereby appoint my beloved wife Susannah McPherson to be the executrix of my will.

I hereby direct my said executrix to pay all my just debts, funeral and testamentary expenses as soon as possible after my decease.

I hereby bequeath to my said beloved wife all my real estate and personal property which may be mine at the time of my decease, including the house and premises where I now reside on the east side of Main Street Westville, also the lot and premises on the corner of Main and Blackdiamond Streets, known as the Munro property, also a piece or parcel of land on the West side of Main Street on the way leading to New Glasgow containing six acres more or less, also a piece of parcel of land on Spring Garden Road containing two acres more or less, together with all my personal property, furniture, bedding, book debts, or other property that may be mine at the time of my decease to be hers absolutely.
