The twenty third day of October in the

I John McTherson of Gairloch in the
County of Victoria, being infirm in body but of perfect
mind and judgement thanks be to Almighty God,
Calling into mind the Mortality of my body and
believing that it is appointed unto all men once to
die, Do make and ordain this my last Will and
testament, that is to say Principally and First of all
I give and recommend my soul unto God who gave
it, and my body I commit to the earth to be buried
with a decent Christian burial nothing doubting
but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the
same again by the Almighty Power of God, and as
touching such worldly Estate as I possess in this life

I give and bequeath in the manner following
1st I give and bequeath to my son Alexander McTherson
Forty dollars Currency to be levied of my estate and
paid to him by my son Donald McTherson within
twelve months after my death.

2nd I give and bequeath to my daughter Peggy
McTherson wife of Angus Baillie of Wick River —
Twenty four dollars currency to be levied of my property
and also paid to her by my son Donald McTherson
in twelve months after my death.

3rd I give and bequeath to my son Donald McTherson
all and singular my lands, messuages, and tenements,
with all the appurtenances, also the stock on the
farm consisting of Horses Cattle and Sheep, with
all the farming Implements and other Carriage,
together with the Household furniture and other
Goods and Chattels such as the joinery Tools,
and also all my Credits, thereby give and will
to the said Donald McTherson, the same to be freely

possessed and enjoyed by him, without let,
hindrance, or incumbrance whatever.


And I do utterly revoke and disannul
all and every other former Testaments, Wills, Legacies,
by me in anywise before named called or bequeathed;
Ratifying and Confirming this and no other to be
my last Will and Testament, and to see that all
things contained in every item of the above may be
duly executed I do hereby nominate and appoint
Murdoch McKenzie and Alexander McKenzie
(William's son) both of Fairlock in the County of
Pictou, aforesaid.
