during her natural life, and also to maintain

they obtain their maturity.

2^d I give and bequeath to my beloved
wife Anne M^cTherson the House and one acre
of land already named in the foregoing presents
during the term of her natural life and also
one half of the farm stock which one half
is again to be equally divided between her the
said Anne M^cTherson and my son John M^c
Therson.

3^d I give and bequeath to my son
