manner and form.


First, I give and bequeath to my beloved wife

my estate, I constitute, make, and ordain Allan
McQuarrie Young River (brother in law to my dear
wife Bella) and Alexander McQuarrie Mac-
wood Hill (Simon's son) the executors of this my
last will and testament, In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this third

Eight hundred and Eighty two.
