farming utensils for her use and benefit, and she has  
power should the deem it necessary to sell the remain-  
-ing half before my two sons hereinafter mentioned shall  
come to be twenty one years of age, the money or proceeds  
to be used, to their benefit,

Third, I grant and bequeath to James Lawrence  
my eldest son one fourth part of the above mentioned  
farm,

Fourth, I grant and bequeath to my second son Duncan  
Howard the remaining one fourth part of the said farm

Fifth, I grant and bequeath to Mary Beth my youngest  
sister the sum of twenty five dollars,

And lastly, I appoint Duncan Ross Tanner, and  
Alexander Campbell (both of Sutherlands River) the  
Executors of this my last Will and Testament,
