will be suitable for her, that is to say, the above to be  
provided for, for the said Sarah Catherine while  
unmarried and living in the family, with the full use  
of house as before.

3<sup>rd</sup> I will and bequeath to my beloved son Allan, to his  
heirs and assigns all my estate real and personal,  
moveable and immovable and all appurtenances  
on estate, except all that provided for in above Rec<sup>s</sup>  
1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup>.

4<sup>th</sup> I in my last Will and testament, appoint as Executor  
of the same Will and testament my beloved son Hugh John  
Duncan Chisholm of New Glasgow. To the above last  
Will and testament I set my hand and Seal in presence  
of the undersigned witnesses, and those witness each other.
