

I know all men by these

memory do make and publish and
declare this my last will and
Testament as follows viz

First I give and bequeath to my

time or as long as she likes to
stay on the premises together
with all cellars, houses, shops
farming utensils and all the
household furniture of whatever
kind, my watch and all things
in the house of whatever kind
with seven hundred dollars of
money to be given her by my
executors for her own personal use
for ever.

Second I give and bequeath to Alan
McMillan my son the farm I
own at Bridgville on which I reside
subject to the claims of his mother
during her life time for his
own use for ever.

Thirdly I give and bequeath to
William Guinness my daughter
the sum of one hundred and fifty

Dollars
Fourthly - I give and bequeath to Anne
the B. M. Mullan the sum of one
hundred and fifty Dollars

Fifthly - I give and bequeath to
John J. Mullan my son
the sum of fifty dollars and
my sword

Sixthly I give and bequeath to
Thomas M. Andrews the sum of
Twenty five Dollars and my share
of the property I own at Budge
with in company with the Andrews
his father

Seventhly - I by this set read the
all former wills as null & void

Eighthly - I declare and appoint
Anne the B. M. Mullan my daughter
and the M. Andrews as executors of
this my last will and testament
I do hereby whereby I have
hereunto set my hand and seal
and published and declared this to be
my last will and testament in the
presence of the witnesses named
below this 22 day of January A.D. 1903
