on the main road (west side) for her benefit  
and behoof for ever.

5. I give and bequeath to my Brother William  
The piece of land adjoining Mary Townsend's  
line, between the main road & the Intercolonial  
Railway, extending southerly to the drain, containing  
about two acres, more or less, for his own benefit  
and behoof for ever, excepting the roadway into my house.

6. I give and bequeath to my nephew Albin S.  
Chisholm, William's son the lot of land in New  
Glasgow upon which my Brother William now lives  
for his benefit and behoof for ever, with buildings thereon.

7. I give and bequeath to Mrs. Mary E. McLeod  
The sum of Fifty dollars when my Executors can  
do so, out of the proceeds of my Estate,

8. I give and bequeath to my executors to be named  
herein by me the Residue of my Real Estate lands and  
houses and also the residue of all my personal  
property goods and chattels in Trust, with full  
power to sell and convey the same at such times  
and in such manner as they shall consider  
most advantageous to my Estate. The proceeds  
to be devoted and given to the following purposes.

1<sup>st</sup> First for the payment of bequests herein already made  
secondly to the Trustees of James Church the sum of  
Six Hundred Dollars for the payment of the debt  
on the manse, 3<sup>rd</sup> to the British and Foreign Bible  
Society of London the sum of Two Hundred Dollars.

4<sup>th</sup> The Home Mission Scheme of the Presbyterian Church  
in Canada <sup>Eastern Section</sup> Two Hundred dollars. 5<sup>th</sup> The Residue  
of my Estate to be given to the Foreign mission scheme  
of the Presbyterian Church in Canada Eastern Section,  
and the French Evangelical Scheme of said Church

9. I hereby revoke any former will made by me  
10. I hereby appoint and constitute James W. Fraser (Baird) Esq. & George W. Underwood of New Glasgow Executors of this my last Will and Testament.

11. I order that the bequests to my sisters Flora McPherson & Mrs. Mary M. Troil shall be fully provided for by my Executors before the other personal bequests are paid, dated at New Glasgow this eighteenth day August A.D. 1880.

3<sup>d</sup> I ordain that my Executors shall have full power to invest the proceeds of my Estate as it may be sold from time to time in such securities as they shall consider most advantageous for my estate.


