2nd I will devise and bequeath to my sister Jane Goumes twenty five dollars

3rd I will devise and bequeath to Carrie Jean widow of John Frazer one hundred dollars

4th I will devise and bequeath to my brother Alexander Morrison the balance of my money real or personal and all my real and personal property both by gift and by purchase and appoint John R Bell of Fall Springs and Geo Bacon of Sullivan both in the County of Putnam the executors of this my last will and testament the within writing I have hereunto signed and sealed published and all this twenty seventh day of May A D 1840
