to which I shall be entitled at the time

McKenzie, widow of the late Daniel Mc
Kenzie to have and to hold the same
to her the said Euphemia McKenzie
her heirs and assigns to her sole and
separate use free from and indepen-
dent of the debts and liabilities of her
husband. Should she again marry
and with full power to dispose of the
same or any part thereof by deed will
or other conveyance as she may deem
proper.

I order and direct that my
Executrix and Executor hereafter
named do out of my personal estate
erect a suitable monument to the
memory of my late husband and of
myself.

I hereby nominate and appoint
the said Euphemia McKenzie and Richard
Tanner of Pictou Esquire, Executrix and Executor
of this my will.

I hereby revoke all my prior
testamentary dispositions and declare this
to be my last will and testament.
