

This is the last Will and Testament of me
Donald Munroe of Cambo, in the County of Pictou,
Farmer, of the same place.

First, I give devise and bequeath to my son
Donald Munroe the Farm that I now reside on
Containing one hundred Aears more or less,
To have and to hold the same for him and his
heirs for ever, subject to and chargeable with
the support and maintenance of his mother and
my beloved wife Nancy Munroe in the following
manner, that is to say my beloved wife the said
Nancy Munroe shall have the use of the one
half of the House, with the one half of my
household furniture, and bedding during her
life time. Also that my said son Donald
Munroe will give or cause to be given to my
beloved wife the said Nancy Munroe, annually
two barrels of good flour, one barrel of Pot-
meal and twenty bushels of potatoes. Also
she is to have the use of two Cows and Six
Sheep for her own use and benefit and all
increase accruing from such Stock above
mentioned, during her life, should she survive me.

I also give devise and bequeath to my
second daughter Jesse Munroe the use of
the sitting room fronting the harbour, and
the bedroom she now occupies with suitable
bedding so long as she remains unmarried -
and after the death of her mother with all the
furniture and bedding usually used in said
rooms.

Also I give devise and bequeath to my
beloved wife Nancy Munroe the Crown Lot I
now own in the town of New Glasgow fronting the
street leading from New Glasgow to Little
Harbour, and joining the lands of William Ross

James M. May, and John M. May, Esqs. - Containing
three quarters of an Acor more or less, to have and
to hold the same to her and her heirs for ever,
if not disposed of during my life time.

Lastly, I give and bequeath to my son Donald
Munroe all the residue of my property of what
soever nature after the payment of my just debts
and funeral expenses to have and to hold the
same to him and his heirs for ever.

And I nominate and appoint
Archibald M. May and Donald Fraser Esqs.
Executors of this my last Will and Testament
hereby revoking all other and former Wills.
