

This is the last Will and Testament of me William Munro of Westville, in the County of Pictou, Yeoman.

I hereby revoke all wills by me at any time heretofore made.

I appoint my son John G. Munro, of Middle River in Pictou County and William McInnes of Westville in Pictou County to be my Executors of this my will.

I will and direct that my said Executors shall first pay all of my just debts and funeral expenses.

I give and devise all the homestead on which I now reside, situate on Church Street in the said Town of Westville, to my wife Catherine Munro for the term of her natural life, and at her death this said property to be the property of my son Albert E. Munro and Bessie Munro, and Sarah Munro, my Daughters in equal shares.

I give and devise to my Daughter Sarah Munro the sum of five hundred dollars.

I give and devise to my Daughter Bessie Munro the sum of Five hundred dollars.

I give and devise to my son John G. Munro, the sum of two hundred Dollars.

I give and devise to my son Albert E. Munro the sum of Two hundred dollars.

I give and devise to William Hugh McNaughton and to Daniel W. McNaughton fifty dollars each.

I give and devise to my son Charles Munro the sum of One hundred dollars.

I give and devise to Maud McDonald and Alexander McDonald (children of my Daughter Mrs. Sophia McDonald now deceased) the sum of one hundred dollars each.

I give and devise the residue of my property if any, to my wife Catherine Munro.
