These presents do witness

That I Abigail Murray of Lower  
Bannys River in the County of Peterborough  
and Province of Nova Scotia and  
Dominion of Canada make this as  
my will and Testament, that is to say  
First - I do hereby order will and  
devise unto and to my son Andrew  
William Murray all and singular  
the real estate by the last will of my  
husband late Walter Murray of said  
Lower Bannys River in said County  
as expressed and set forth and described  
in his will bearing date the tenth day  
of 1872 of December and the same eight  
hundred and seventy two and all the  
buildings and erections thereon  
subject to the conditions hereafter  
set forth and expressed  
Second - I hereby order and give to  
my daughter Mauda Murray the  
full right to have hold and enjoy  
to her own use benefit and behoof  
(so long as she remains unmarried)  
and she shall enjoy the same  
that is to say. Her Parlor on the  
floor of the dwelling house as already  
x provided and the furniture thereon  
also the bed room over the kitchen  
in the main house, with bedstead bed  
and bedding and furniture, also  
the said Mauda shall have the

to her use and benefit proper and suitable  
Books and clothing in the like condition  
and state as the the said Decedent has  
been maintained in while living with  
me her mother, and in sickness  
medical attendance of a Doctor with  
proper nursing and attendance  
also after death decent Christian  
burial all which shall be provided  
for and done by the said Decedent  
William Murray or his heirs or  
assigns in good faith

The said Decedent William Murray  
shall keep and support on the  
premises with proper maintenance  
and shelter one cow and three  
sheep yearly and every year to the  
sole use and benefit of the said  
Decedent who shall have the sole  
disposal of the proceeds thereof  
also if the said Decedent shall  
while she remains unmarried have  
good cause to live separate from the  
said Decedent William Murray the said  
Decedent shall have right to take  
her bedstead bed and bedding and  
furniture to her use and benefit in  
her separate residence so long as  
she shall require the same there-  
after to revert to the said Decedent  
William Murray  
This, my executed last will and testament  
shall pay all my just debts and  
funeral expenses and shall

procure and erect a suitable Head  
Stone at the grave of said Walter  
Murray and myself after my  
body is returned as I desire it  
shall be along with the remains  
of my said husband

I do hereby name Constituents  
and appointing son Andrew Murray  
Murray my executor of this my  
will and I declare this as my  
sole will and Testament witnessed  
by my name, hereto signed  
and my seal affixed this day and  
year herein above first written
