

This is the last will and Testament
of me Samuel Murray of Pleasant
Valley in the County of Pictou
Farmer I hereby revoking all former
wills

I direct all my just debts
funeral and extraordinary expenses to be
paid and satisfied by my executors
hereafter named as soon as con-
veniently may be after my decease

I direct and bequeath to my son
James Wm Murray the farm and
premises of which I reside at
Pleasant Valley ground, as well
as all my household furniture
and other like sort implements of
my kind and described above
on my said farm subject however
to the care and maintenance of my
wife Jennie Murray and my
father I shall have during their
lives or so long as they reside on my
said farm and I direct that the
care and maintenance of my said
wife and father shall be a lien on
my said farm

I direct my two trustees
on Park and Hayden Streets in the town
of New Glasgow said Executors James
John Dair Murray and I direct my
executors hereafter named to collect
all rents from said land mentioned
judicially and debts the proceeds
therefrom to the care of said trustees
and the maintenance of my family
until my son James Wm Murray shall

attain the age of twenty one years
when he shall take full charge of
said property to his own absolute use
and
forever

I request all moneys I may
have in the Bank to be drawn out
my two daughters I named Ann
Murray but I direct my eye into
said trustees & please the said
James Murray to be paid
by them to my said daughters in
equal shares on their attaining
the age of twenty one years or at
their marriage if married before
attaining the age of twenty one years

I nominate and appoint John W.
Murray of Scotland in said County
Midlothian and James Murray of
Robert Murray of London
to be the trustees and executors
of the said will
