

I Robert Murray of Merigomish, County of
Pictou, having by Gods Blessing lived a long life,
in this world, think it proper to arrange my worldly
matters so that at my death there may be no cause
of Dispute what each of my family are to receive,
after my death, in the first place then, I give and
Bequeath to the British and ^{Foreign} Bible Society the
sum of twenty Dollars, I also give and Bequeath
to the foreign Missionary Society, the sum of forty
Dollars also to the Deaf and Dumb institution of
Halifax the sum of twenty Dollars. — in all \$ 80.

I also give and bequeath to each of my children,
alive at my death one Dollar each, except my youngest
son David Francis Murray to whom I give and bequeath
all and singular every thing both real estate and
personall property which I possess at the time of my
death, I also appoint him the said David Francis Murray
my sole executor of this my Last Will and Testament,
all other wills being void and null, I order him
my said executor as soon as possible after my death,
to lose no time in paying off these sums above
mentioned to his Brothers and Sisters, with the
other sums for religious and benevolent purposes.
