I give devise and bequeath the
residue of my estate both real and
personal of whatever kind and
whenever situated of which I may
be possessed as follows one
half to my wife Isabella Olding
and one half to my son John Olding
the half bequeathed to my wife
being for use and maintenance
during her life time only and
at her death I give and bequeath
the same to my son John Olding
