I, John P. Olding, Farmer, Merigomish, County of Pictou, Province of Nova Scotia, & Dominion of Canada, being weak in body, but sound in memory and understanding, do hereby make, sign, & seal, This My Last Will and Testament in manner following -

1. I hereby commit my soul to God in Christ, and my Body to my heirs to be by them decently committed to the Earth, and afterwards that a suitable tomb stone shall be erected, where my dust is laid to rest in the hope of a blessed resurrection.
2. I hereby appoint and direct my Executors hereinafter named, to pay all my deathbed and Funeral expenses, and all my other just and lawful debts, out of my estate, and also to collect all debts justly due to me, in the way and time authorized by Law.
3. I hereby devise and bequeath to my Brother Richard E. Olding, the sum of Forty Dollars (\$40.00) Dominion Currency.
4. I hereby devise and bequeath to my Sisters Mary Ann Olding and Catharine S. Olding, One Hundred and Twenty dollars (\$120.00) each, and after all other claims are met, provided there be a residue, the same shall be equally divided between them.
5. I hereby devise and bequeath to my sister Mrs. Ann Cummings, the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00)
6. I hereby devise and bequeath to my sister Elizabeth N. wife of James D. Copeland, and Harriot M. wife of Daniel M. Gregor, the sum of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) each.
7. I hereby devise and bequeath to the Board of Foreign Missions of Presbyterian Church in Canada, in the Maritime Provinces, the sum of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00)
8. I hereby constitute and appoint, My Brothers W. C. Olding Esq. and Nicholas P. Olding my Executors,

and direct them under the Authority of the Court  
of Probate, to pay all my just and lawful debts,  
to collect all debts justly due to me, and otherwise  
to pay all the above bequests & to fulfil <sup>all</sup> the duties The Reg.  
included in that Trust.

In testimony of my adherence to the above de-  
tails of this My Last Will and Testament, I, in the  
presence of the witnesses here subjoined, have set  
my Hand and Seal, on the Twenty Fourth day of May,  
in the Year of our Lord, One Thousand Eight Hundred  
and Eighty three years.
