

I William C. Elding of Merigomish in the County of Hinton, Farmer, do hereby make public, and declare, this my last Will and Testament, at the same time revoking any former will by me at any time heretofore made.

First. It is my will, that first out of the proceeds of my estate my executors hereinafter named pay all my just debts and funeral expenses and the expenses attendant upon the settlement of my estate.

Second. I give devise and bequeath to my beloved daughter Mary Jane Elding the farm on which I now reside situate at Merigomish aforesaid, to have and to hold the same and every part thereof to her and her heirs forever.

Third. I also give and bequeath to my said beloved daughter Mary Jane the sum of eight hundred dollars.

Fourth. The residue of my estate I give and bequeath to my three daughters Mary Jane Elding, Christina Grant wife of Thomas Grant, Jennima Pitcey, wife of J. A. Pitcey and their heirs, those and share alike, to be paid to them, and each of them by my Executors as soon as convenient after my decease.

Fifth. I hereby appoint my said daughter Mary Jane Elding, and my said son in law Thomas Grant of said Merigomish, Farmer, the Executors and Executor of this my last Will, and I direct that my said son in law shall receive fifteen dollars in lieu of Commission for any trouble he may have connected with the settlement of my estate.
