make and publish this my last and Testament
as follows.

First, I will and bequeath to my wife Hannah the farm
on which I now reside together with the ~~land~~
barn and all other buildings or outhouses thereon,
also all my household furniture of every kind,
also all the stock, including horses, cattle, and
sheep, also all farming implements of every kind, also
all harness, horse tackling, and all other property
of whatever kind it may be, that I may own at
the time of my death, for her sole use and benefit
during her natural life.

Second, On the death of my wife Hannah I will and
bequeath all the above mentioned property or
whatever part of it may be remaining to my
daughter Sarah Jane for her sole use and benefit.

Lastly, I do hereby appoint John Thompson, Blacksmith,
of this place and George Murray, Medical Doctor,
of New Glasgow, Executors of this my last will and
Testament. In witness whereof, I hereunto set my hand
and seal this fourteenth day of November, One
Thousand eight hundred and seventy six.
