Roderic McDonald of Trenton, in the County aforesaid,
Provided nevertheless that my wife the said Janet Powell
shall have full power to sell the said Real Estate,
and personal property if necessary for her support during
her life time,

Lastly, I do hereby nominate and appoint Roderic
McDonald aforesaid of Trenton to be sole Executor
of this my last Will and testament.
