to each, all my personal and household effects

any money or valuables whether on hand at
the time of my decease or otherwise invested
in Bank Stock or deposits or otherwise, To
Have and to hold the same to her the said
Ellen Mooney in her own right for herself and
her heirs forever.

I do hereby appoint my son in law
John Mooney and my friend Charles Holmes of
Stellarton aforesaid to be executors of this my last
Will and Testament.
