This is the last Will and Testament of me Lane
Kate Crege, at present of the town and County of Hinton
in the Province of Nova Scotia, Widow.

I give devise and bequeath unto my son John
Crege of the City of Chicago in the United States of
America merchant absolutely my silver Candlesticks
and white and gold tea set, also silver toddy ladle.

I give and devise and bequeath unto my
son James P. Crege of the City of Ottawa in the
Dominion of Canada Banker absolutely my wedge
wood tea set and silver Candlestick and silver
manner spoon.

I give devise and bequeath to my grand
daughter Jane the daughter of my son Harry
H. Crege of Antigonish and Province of Nova
Scotia my gold watch and chain.

I give devise and bequeath to Margaret
wife of my said son Harry H. Crege a gold bracelet.

To my said three sons John, James P.
and Harry H. Crege my linen marked with the
name of "Hutton" to be equally divided between them.

All the real and residue of my estate,
real and personal of every kind and nature which
I own or possess and all moneys and
Cash which I shall save out of my income and
which may or may not be invested in stocks I

give and devise the same unto my daughter
Lena Boyd, wife of William Boyd of Edinburgh
Scotland, sister to the said absolutely for her
sole and separate use free from and without being
subject to the debts or control of her present or any
future husband.

Should there be devised to me under the
will or wills of any of my relations residing in England
or elsewhere any property real or personal I give and

devise the same absolutely to my children the said John Cerar, James P. Cerar, Laura Boyd and Harry H. Cerar, to receive in the proportion of two thirds of the same and the said John Cerar and James P. Cerar in the proportion of one third of same.

Should my said daughter Laura Boyd die without children her surviving, then I order and direct that the foregoing bequests in this my will made to her, be divided in even proportions between my three sons John, James P. and Harry H. Cerar.

I hereby nominate and appoint my said three sons hereinafore named, namely John Cerar, James P. Cerar, and Harry H. Cerar and the survivor of them as the executors and trustees under this my last will and Testament hereby revoking all former wills and Testaments by me at any time heretofore made and declare this to be my last will and testament.
