Will as follows.

1st I give devise and bequeath to my wife Catherine
Simpson and her heirs executors, administrators
and assigns the farm lot on which I reside at
French River and bounded as follows, on the East
by lands of John Tocher, on the South by lands of the
Heirs of David Simpson and Alexander Simpson,
on the west by the several courses of the River until
it comes to the lands of William Simpson, on the North
by the lower line of the first division of lands containing
one hundred acres more or less, with the buildings
and improvements thereon, To Have and To Hold
the same forever.

2nd I give devise and bequeath to my wife Catherine Simpson
and her heirs, executors, and administrators and
assigns all my personal property of whatever nature
or description, and Mortgage, promissory notes, and
Bank accounts, which shall remain after paying
all my just debts, funeral expenses, and proving
this my last will.

I hereby appoint my said wife Catherine
Simpson and John D. Fraser of French River, executor
and executor of this my last Will and testament, I do
