Will and Testament, hereby revoking all former
Wills by me at any time made,

1st I give, devise and bequeath to each of my
two nephews, equally, Jacob Henry, and Raymond
Willard Lippincott of said Chelsea a certain lot
or parcel of land, situated, partly in two Counties,
of Colchester, and County of Pictou in Nova Scotia,
said lot of land contains about six (600)
hundred acres more or less, and being the same
premises conveyed to me about the year 1870, and
described in the Registry of Deeds of the two above
named Counties, (Colchester & Pictou.)

In witness whereof, I the said Jacob Waddle Lippincott,
hereunto set my hand and Seal this sixth day of
April, A.D. Eighteen hundred and eighty one.
