and Testament hereby revoking
all former wills & Testaments
dispositions hereof or at any
time by me made

I hereby appoint John Findlay
Mr Donald and John B Day
to be the executors of my will

I hereby direct my said mentioned
executors to pay all my just
debts funeral and Testamentary
expenses as soon as possible
after my decease

I hereby bequeath to my wife
Christina Cameron and to my
daughter Jessie Cameron the money
on deposit in Bank to be divided
equally between them

I hereby devise my house, barn
and farm on which I now reside
(which farm is described in
the deed) to my son James Hugh
Cameron and to my wife
Christina Cameron with equal
rights to each and upon the
decease of my wife the property

above mentioned shall revert absolutely
to my son James Hugh Cameron

It is provided that my daughter
Jessie Cameron shall always
have a home in above mentioned
house should she so desire same
and on the occasion of her marriage
and her own free will in her
home elsewhere she shall have
our love and good wishes

I hereby devise my property and
my share of the property at the Kellans
Mountain formerly occupied by
my father during his life time
to my son Joseph Robert Cameron
