declare this to be my last will and Testament

I hereby appoint Hugh Ross of New
Glasgow a friend and mediator, Thomas a
McLean of Charlottetown Prince Edwards
Island Messrs. J. Smith & Son
of said New Glasgow Barren executors of
this my last will and the Trustees and
Guardians of my said children
hereafter named, I sell all my
real estate and personal property
wherein situated unto my said executors
their heirs executors and administrators
upon Trust to sell the same or any
part or parts thereof and to convert
the same or any part or parts
thereof into money and after paying
all just debts due by me at the
time of my death and my personal
expenses and the expenses of settling
my estate to hold and apply the
balance in so much thereof as
may be necessary or advisable
in the maintenance of my said
dependents or the survivors or
survivors of them from time to
time as occasion may require
to the support and education of my
said children Mary Ashwood
Johnston and Mary Johnston
and I do hereby devise and bequeath
all the said balance of my estate
in the hands or under the control
of my said executors to my said
said children Mary Ashwood
Johnston and Mary Johnston
John and John also absolutely

used in the event of the death of
either of my above named Grand
children deceased and before the age of
twenty one years then the whole
balance remaining on such account
shall go to the survivor and his or
her heirs forever, my executors may
retain any part of the said balance
if they deem it advisable so to do
until the said Mary Johnston shall
arrive at the age of twenty one years
or they sell and dispose of the whole
as ordered in their decision, the
advances to be made during their
minority to the said Mary Johnston
Johnston and Mary Johnston
shall be altogether in the decision
of my said executors and any
advances made to either of my
said Grandchildren shall at the
final settlement be deducted from
his or her share respectively and
my said executors are authorized if
they deem it advisable to pay out
the whole balance in advances to
my said Grandchildren for their
support & education before they
arrive at the age of twenty one
I authorize my executors to make
and expend funds of any or all
real estate left by me without
application to the Probate or any
other Court, my said executors shall
be at liberty to appoint one of their
members or any other person in
their discretion to look after the
management of the real and
personal estate left by me

collected rents and turnover such business
as may be necessary and to allow a
just and fair remuneration therefor
during the minority of my said
grandchildren, I do further declare
that my said executors and Trustees
shall respectively be chargeable only
for such money as they shall
actually receive and shall not
be answerable for each other or for
any banker or other person
in whose hands my Trust funds
may be placed nor otherwise for
any ordinary losses
