I also give to said Margaret B. Sutherland an organ, now in the house, together with all the household furniture to her and her mother share and share alike.

And I do nominate, and appoint my wife Christy Ann Sutherland, and my daughter Margaret B. Sutherland the Executrices of this my last Will and Testament.
