After payment of all my just debts
funeral and testamentary expenses I give
devise and bequeath all my real
and personal property to my beloved
wife Ellen Cameron to be held by her
during her life time and after her
death to be sold and the proceeds
divided equally between my daughters
namely, Cecelia, Betsy, Ellen
Belle and Josephine or the
survivors of them or the whole to be
paid to the survivors of them if only
one of my said daughters should be
living at the death of my said wife.

I should my said wife and my said
daughters or the survivors of them
wish to sell the said property
previous to the death of my said wife
they may do so by mutual agreement
in writing signed by my said wife and
my said daughters or the survivors of
them and the proceeds of such sale
to be divided equally between my
said wife and my said daughters or
the survivors of them.

My said wife is to furnish a
home for my said daughters or the
survivors of them as long as they
remain unmarried and wish to
live with her on the said property
after the death of my said wife
should my said daughters or the

survivors of them mutually agree
not to sell the said property they
may occupy it or otherwise divide
it between themselves as they may

express of new Glasgow Parliament
Executor of this my last will and
Testament
