Carmichael Lot and the called as
follows From the Northwest corner up the
South side of Robert Spring Brook to Rogers
old Road along the lower side of said Road
to the top of the hill to a spruce tree marked
thence south to McKays line and down both of them
at Carmichaels corner also that certain
lot of land of the said Paul Jones McKays line
towards the said gate by sixteen Rods back
on McKays side and the use of all farm
ing utensils in possession with Thomas his
Wife

Thirdly I hereby give and bequeath to my
beloved Son Thomas the remaining
part

part of Logan Co. from the front to the rear
and also one horse two Cows pig sheep
the use of all farming implements in com-
mon with Neal Colver for Mother and my
Watch and Gun and the remainder of
what stock there may be I give and
bequeath to my son Malcolin. And I
~~highly recommend that my son Malcolin~~
do support and provide for his Mother
and if he have a family of his own
and his Mother shall have a separate
part of the house his Mother then to
have her own Bed room the Kitchen
and one half of the cellar and one
half of the left side of the farm house
and the garden as the two Mother divides the
same Malcolin to keep for her one Cow for
sheep summer and winter and give her yearly
two Barrels Flour one Barrel Oatmeal
Five Bushels Potatoes Five Bushels Turnips
and Five Dollars in Cash of the kind and
it as long as she lives.

And I give and bequeath
my family Bible to my son Malcolin
and the remainder of my Books as they
my wife and sons Malcolin and Thomas
please to divide them.

And I hereby appoint
my beloved son David McKinnon my Executor
and administrator of this my Last Will
and Testament.
