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

of the Other Part, **Witnesseth**, that the said parties of the first part

for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar

of the Dominion of Canada, to the said parties of the first part

at or before the ensembling and delivery of **These Presents**, the receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged, **have and each of them hath** given, granted,
released, and quitted claim to, and by these Presents do give, grant, release and
quit claim, unto the said party of the second part **his**

Heirs and Assigns, **All** that certain lot, piece or parcel of land, situate lying and being at Bayview in the County of Pictou, in the Province of Nova Scotia, Canada, bounded and described as follows:- Bounded on the north by Narrow Entrance to Carriboo Harbour, on the east by Nortumberland Straits, on the south by the lands of William Munro, and on the west by the lands of the estate of John McDonald, containing forty five acres more or less, together with the right of way through the property of William Munro to the Bayview Road.

ALSO all that other piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being at Bayview aforesaid, bounded and described as follows:- Bounded on the north by lands of James Hughan, on the east by lands of the estate of John McDonald, on the south by the lands of William Munro, and on the west by lands of Donald Leslie, containing fifty acres more or less, the same being intersected by the Bayview Road,



together with all and singular the Easements, Hereditaments and Appurtenances to the same belonging, or in anywise appertaining, with the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof, and all the estate, right, title, interest, claim, property and demand, both at Law and in Equity of the said
