I, George H. Davis of River John Road,  
Pictou, being sick and weak in body, but of  
perfect mind and memory thanks be given to  
God, calling into mind the mortality of my  
body, and knowing that it is appointed for  
all men once to die, do make, ordain, this my  
last will, that is to say first of all, I give and  
recommend my soul to God who gave it and  
my body to the earth to be buried in decent  
Christian burial at the discretion of my Executors  
nothing doubting but that at the general  
resurrection, I shall receive the same back  
again from God, and as touching such world-  
ly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to  
bless me in this life I give, and demise, and  
dispose of the same in the following manner,  
I give and bequeath to my dear beloved wife  
Jessie, my farm stock and farming imple-  
ments, household goods, debts, and moveables,  
to be hers and her heirs for ever.

I appoint to be my Executors, John  
Dayden, Westville, and Nathan Styles, ~~both~~ River  
John Road, of this my last will, and I do hereby  
disallow, revoke, and disannul all and every  
other former testaments, wills, legacies, bequests,  
and Executors by me in any wise, named,  
will and bequeathed, ratifying and con-  
firming this and no other to be my last  
will and testament, In witness whereof
