time, do make and ordain this my Last  
Will and Testament.

I give devise and bequeath to my

estate and personal property I own in this  
County, or elsewhere, including a two seventh  
interest in the property of the late Hugh  
M. May, my wifes father of Fox Brook  
in this County, also twenty Shares in the Union  
Co. operative store at Stillartown in this County,  
also the ~~proceeds~~ proceeds of two insurance  
policies on my life amounting to two thousand  
two hundred dollars to be used for her support  
and the support of any members of my family  
who may be unable to work for his or her  
living. In the event however, if my widow getting  
married again she shall receive one third of the  
property then to the fore, and the remaining two  
thirds shall be devoted to the interests of my children  
according to the best judgment of my Executor.

I appoint my beloved wife  
Isabella Demoon my executrix and James Macquell  
underground manager for the Occasion Coal mining  
Company Westville, Executor to act along my said  
wife as executrix of this my last Will.
