All my other estate, real or personal I give and bequeath to my niece said Jane McGarvey and her said children herein mentioned to be divided as follows:-  
~~said Jane McGarvey to have one half part and the other half part to be divided between said children equally.~~

I hereby nominate and appoint David William McGarvey to be the executor of this my last Will and Testament and direct that he may administer my estate without giving surety.
