I, John Duncan Cameron of Scotch Hill in the County of Pictou, farmer, do hereby make this my last will and testament.

After payment of my debts and funeral and testamentary expenses, including the cost of a suitable monument I give and bequeath one hundred dollars unto Jennie May Cameron, daughter of Sarah Jane Cameron.

I give devise and bequeath the residue of my estate real and personal unto Arthur Chambers Cameron son of said Sarah Jane Cameron.

I appoint John Dunbar and William McQuarrie both of Scotch Hill aforesaid executors of this will.

And whereas I am the sole executor of the last will and testament of said Sarah Jane Cameron, deceased, dated the twenty-fourth day of June A.D., 1899 and duly proved and registered in the Court of Probate for said county of Pictou, and whereas by the said last will and testament I am constituted guardian of her three children, said Jennie May Cameron, and Arthur Chambers Cameron, and Everett Arnold Cameron, and also trustee of her estate; and whereas the said estate is not yet fully administered, and the said Arthur Chambers Cameron and Jennie May Cameron are still infants, I do hereby appoint and constitute the said John Dunbar and William McQuarrie and the survivor of them, in succession to me, to be executors of and in respect of the said last will and testament of said Sarah Jane Cameron, and guardians of the said infants Arthur Chambers Cameron and Jennie May Cameron, and trustees of the said estate of Sarah Jane Cameron; and I do hereby devise and bequeath unto the said John Dunbar and William McQuarrie and the survivor of them as such executors, guardians and trustees, all of said

estate, real and personal property, of said Sarah Jane Cameron in trust for the purposes of and under the terms of the said last will and testament of said Sarah Jane Cameron.

I revoke all wills by me at any time heretofore made.
