I know all men by these presents
that I William Cairnes of Garden of
Eden, County of Peter and Province
of Ulster Sedition do make and publish
that my last will and Testament
full my will is that all my just
debts be paid by my executors
hereinafter named

Record I will to my son Dan Hugh
Cairnes of Garden of Eden County
of Peter and Province of Ulster
Sedition all my right title and
possession of the south side of my
farm the line running parallel
with north and south lines and
including buildings

To my son Andrew Gray Cairnes
of Garden of Eden County of Peter
and Province of Ulster Sedition I
will all my right title and
possession of the north side of my
farm to the said Andrew Gray Cairnes
south line will be Dan Hugh
Cairnes north line

Also my will and desire is that
Andrew Gray Cairnes Cairnes
shall be a defensor of the part of the
farm in any way to any persons
outside of the family

Finally - My will and desire is
that Dan Hugh Cairnes of
place aforesaid and my wife
Christy Cairnes of same place

have equal rights and privileges of
the house and especially that she
have the right of occupying the bed
rooms adjoining the kitchen and
further that a deed given in favor
of plain appeared to have the right
and privilege of sleeping in the room
on the west side of the house
Fourthly my will and desire is that
Dau Hugh Cameron of plain of record
will leave the right of hauling wood
and fire wood and whatever else he
may wish to haul on the road north
coming from the east side of the
River to the barns, also that he will
leave the right of getting water on
any part of the farm.

I also desire and request to my
wife Christy Cameron of plain
appear two young cows now on
the place also three sheep

To my son Dau Hugh Cameron
of plain of record I desire and
request all the remainder of the
stock

My will and desire is that
Dau Hugh Cameron of plain of record
do support and keep my wife and
my wife Christy Cameron in during
the life time, also that in case
Dau Hugh Cameron of plain of record
get married and that my wife
Christy Cameron takes her

in a small house by herself the
Dau Hugh Gammum will have to
build such a house for her in
such a place as she desires

I hereby (renewed and approved
as appears to this my last will
and Testament Alexander in bond
and Aledur Ham both of Gaardm of
Eden and County of Pictou Province
of Nova Scotia
