Concerns do make this my last will
and Testament in form as follows

I recommend my soul to God who save it
and my body to the dust in the hope
of a blessed resurrection through Jesus
Christ and my worldly property I
dispose of as follows

First To my daughter Nancy (Mrs Green)
I give and bequeath fifty Dollars in
two years from execution of will
Second to my son Gordon Campbell
I give the same that is to say fifty Dollars
Third to my widow I give and bequeath
along with her legal thirds of the farm
forty Dollars per year and a couple of
part of the house to live in and also
one third of the furniture and clothing
belonging to the house to be used or
disposed of as she sees meet
Fourth To my son James I give and
bequeath my farm on which he now
resides to him and his heirs forever
Fifth The stock and implements on the
farm and the remaining two thirds
of the furniture I give and bequeath
to my son James to assist him in paying
the foregoing bequests to his brother and sister
I appoint my sons William and Gordon
