and memory do make and publish this my last
Will and Testament hereby revoking all former
Wills by me at any time heretofore made:—

And as to my worldly Estate and all the property
real personal or mixed of which I shall die
seized or possessed, I devise bequeath and
dispose of in the manner following, to wit:—

and funeral expenses shall by my executors
hereinafter named be paid out of my Estate
as soon after my decease as shall by them
be found convenient.

Item: I give devise and bequeath to my

Dollars each respectively to be paid to them on
demand out of my Estate by my executors
hereinafter named.

I shall die seized or possessed or to which
I shall be entitled at the time of my decease
