at the time of my death and also  
all my personal property excepting  
what money I may possess which  
money is to be given for masses  
for my own and deceased  
members of the family's souls

On my Nephew Donald Henry  
Chisholm I specify to above  
I wish the following condition  
that it is my desire to have the  
farm remain with relatives in  
so far as this can be done thus  
should he have heirs of his own  
in due time he is to bequeath  
the farm to one of them and thus  
descend from father to son  
In the event of his dying  
without issue he is to leave  
the farm by sale or bequest  
to the next on the family descent  
by bequest he disposes of it  
If he chooses to sell the farm  
he is to give the first offer to  
whomever of my relations  
who chooses to buy it. I further

affirmed to the heirs  
James' son of James and  
my nephew Donald Henry  
Shickler as executors to the  
my last will and testament  
deced sealed and
