I Joseph Cornell of Pictou in the County of Pictou, and Province of Nova Scotia, Blacksmith, do make public and declare this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following, that is to say, First after payment of all my funeral and testamentary expenses and lawfull debts, I give devise and bequeath to my beloved wife Catherine for the period of her natural life all my real and personal property of every kind and description what-
-soever.

Second - at the death of my said wife Catherine, I hereby direct that said realty and personally pass to my sons Thomas and William and my daughter Anne in equal shares to be held by them, their heirs and assigns forever.

Third - If one or any of my said Children Thomas, William and Anne should die before my said wife Catherine or die after my said wife Catherine leaving no issue, I direct that the share or shares of my realty and personally thus left by my said Children Thomas, William, and Anne to pass and to go to the survivors in equal shares, their heirs and assigns forever, as the tenor of Case may be.

Fourth - I appoint my wife Catherine to be sole executrix of this my last Will and testament.

Fifth, I revoke all former wills by me made.
