make this my last Will and Testament, viz:

I do devise & bequeath to my beloved wife
Elizabeth all my real and personal property, to have
and to hold during her lifetime; after her decease I
devise and give to my daughters Mary wife of
Henry Matheson, Anna wife of Charles Stewart, Nancy
Jane wife of William Douglas & Eliza my unmarried
daughter what may remain of the above property
equally divided among them, in the event of any of
my daughters dying before my wife leaving no child
or children her portion to go to be equally divided
among the living, but in the event of the deceased
daughter leaving a child or children then the mother's
share to go to her family. I do appoint my wife Elizabeth
Executrix and John W. McNeill and Executor, the executors
if they wish to sell Real Estate or personal property,
at any time they think best.
