Introduction

The following pages list data for all known family members as of <2021-07-20>.

Each immediate family is presented in their own section that contains a graphical family tree as well as a description with information about each referenced person and their children. The child section provides information about the children of the preceding couple. When a child has offspring of their own this is presented in a separate family section for that child. In this case a '+' is used to denote that an individual will appear later in the book as a parent with his/her own children and there is a link to the appropriate family reference number. For children with partners but no offspring the partner data is given with the reference family. Roman numerals, followed by a period, are used to indicate the birth order.

In the chapter titled "Family of the Starting Person" the ancestors of John Ives and ? ? are presented in a kind of enhanced Pedigree Chart which displays the graphic representation of their direct-line ancestors and the children of the couple. This chapter contains information about the couple whose offspring are listed in the later chapters.


The chapter titled "Families of his Descendants" provides details (as known as of the publication date) for the offspring of John Ives and ? ?. There is a chapter for each generation. Relatives are listed in the order of the nearness of their relationship.

Sources for the information provided are given in the footnotes.

This document reports the details of 191 individuals, of whom 106 are male and 81 are female. The sex of 4 individuals is unknown. Of the 67 individuals with recorded birth and death dates, the average lifespan was 51.8 years. Of these, 41 males averaged 49.6 years, and 26 females averaged 55.2 years. The longest living male was Charles Moore Ives (1906–2001), who died aged 95. The longest living female was Jessie Margaret MacMillan (1898–1994), who died aged 96.




Figure 1: George Ives Grave

Matthew reached 73 years of age and died in Pictou, Nova Scotia, Canada, on April 13, 1858.




Figure 3: Grave Stone

4. **Jane Ives** was born on Tuesday, January 07, 1806. She was the daughter of George Ives (2) and Catharine Fraser.

Jane died on May 24, 1856, at the age of 50. She was buried in Greenwood Cemetery, Pictou Landing , NS.

It is not absolutely certain that this Jane Ives is a daughter of George Ives. However, she would be about the correct age and George inherited his Father's property at Fisher's Grant. This wedding was recorded in the Colonial Patriot - Tues. Aug. 13,1833. The paster was Rev. Lewis.

Jane Ives is listed as a student in the 1822-3 school year in the Fisher's Grant School taught by Hugh Dunbar (b.1792). William and Isabella Ives are also listed as students. Hugh Dunbar was later a minister in Summerside P.E.I.

Jane married **Archibald Fraser** on Tuesday, August 06, 1833. They had two children.

Archibald was born in 1801. He reached 91 years of age and died in 1892.

Archibald Fraser was from the West River.



BORN: Scotch Hill, Pictou County 27 January 1849

Commenced working as a Clerk with John T. Ives (General Merchants). After Ives's death, he continued the business with Henry G. Ives, as John T. Ives & Company. Later he obtained, with his partner and F. D. Corbett of Halifax (firm of Corbett & Richardson, Commission Merchants), a controlling interest in the Logan Tannery Co., Lyons Brook, serving successfully as Manager, until the Tannery was destroyed by fire in 1911. Of late years, he spent much of his time in Florida.

Served on Town Council as was Mayor from 1901 - 1905 inclusive.

Married to Laura M. Farquarson - Died March 28/31.

Member of First Presbyterian Church.



William Ives was a merchant in Pictou. He was the original owner of a photograph album which contained many of the old "Ives", "Fraser", "Rood", "Copeland" and "Robertson" photos contained in this Family Tree data base. It was passed to his granddaughter Louisa Reid Ives and finally to her grandson Allan James Robertson. A family bible owned by William is now at the McCulloch Center in Pictou, NS

William is listed as a 58 year old merchant in the 1871 Pictou County census.

The following is a record of a sale of land by William Ives to the British Government to be used as an Indian reservation. The property is located across the harbour from Pictou town.

Transcript of Treaty IT-282/IA-142, (1874)

No. 142.

This INDENTURE made this seventh day of December, in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy-four, between William Ives,

of the town and County of Pictou, in the Province of Nova Scotia merchant,

and Christianna Ives, his wife, of the one part, and Her Majesty Queen Victoria, represented herein by the Minister of the Interior of the Dominion of Canada, of the other part.

WHEREAS, Her said majesty Queen Victoria, represented as aforesaid, has agreed with the said William Ives to purchase the lot of land hereinafter described for the use and benefit of the Micmac Indians in the County of Pictou aforesaid, for the price or sum hereinafter mentioned.

NOW THEREFORE, this Indenture witnesseth that the said William Ives and Christianna Ives his wife, in consideration of the sum of one thousand

one hundred and fifty-seven dollars of lawful money of Canada to the said

William Ives, in hand well and truly paid by Her said Majesty, represented

herein as aforesaid, at or before the ensealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have and each of

them hath granted, bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoffed, released, remised, conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents do and each of them doth grant, biargain, sell, alien, enfeoff, release, remise, convey and confirm unto Her Majesty Queen Victoria, represented as aforesaid, Her heirs and successors.

All that certain lot and piece of land situate, lying and being at Fisher's Grant, in the said County of Pictou, and described as follows, that is to say :-

Beginning on the north shore of Boat Harbour, at the south-east corner of lands owned by James G. Sproull, and running thence north thirty-seven degrees forty-five minutes west by the magnet of June, 1873, along the east line of said Sproull's land seventy-four chains, thence north fifty-two degrees fifteen minutes east by the magnet aforesaid, along the south line of lands owned by the said William Ives, eleven chains and thirty-five links to the west line of Edwin Sproull's land, thence south thirty-seven degrees and forty-five minutes east by the magnet aforesaid, along the last mentioned line and west line of lands owned by James G. Sproull aforesaid and William Powell the elder sixty-one chains and eighty-five links to the waters of Boat Harbour aforesaid, thence south-eastwardly, southwardly and westwardly, and by the various courses of the shore of said Boat Harbour to the place of beginning, containing eighty-nine acres, more or less.

Together with all and singular the houses, outhouses, barns, buildings, ways, waters, watercourses, easements, privileges and appurtenances to the same, belonging or in any wise appertaining, and the reversion and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof, and also all the estate, right, title, interest, claim, property and demand, both at law and in equity of them, the said William Ives and Christianna Ives, his wife, of, in, to or out of the same or any part thereof to have and to hold the said land and premises with the appurtenances and every part thereof unto Her said Majesty Queen Victoria, represented as aforesaid, Her heirs and successor, to Her and their sole use, benefit, and behoof forever.

And the said William Ives doth hereby for himself, his heirs, executors and administrators, grant, covenant, promise, and agree to and with Her said Majesty Queen Victoria, represented as aforesaid, Her heirs and successors, in manner following, that is to say :

That it shall and maybe lawful for Her said Majesty, represented as aforesaid, Her heirs and successors, from time to time and at all times hereafter, peaceably and quietly to enter into the said land and premises,

and to have, hold, occupy, posses and enjoy the same without the lawful

let; suit, hindrance, eviction, denial or disturbance of, from or by the said

William Ives or Christianiia Ives, his wife, or any person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same.

And also, that the said William Ives and Christianna Ives, his wife, or one of them, have a good, sure, perfect and indefeasible estate of inheritance in fee simple in the said land and premises, and have good right, full power and lawful authority to sell and convey the same in manner and form as they are hereby sold and conveyed or mentioned, or intended so to be.

And lastly, that the said William Ives and his heirs, the said land and premises, and every part thereof, unto Her said Majesty Queen Victoria, represented as aforesaid, Her heirs and successors, against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever, shall and will by these presents warrant and forever defend :

Will of Christiana Ives, deceased

Certified Copy for Reg of Deeds

I Christiana Ives of Pictou in the County of Pictou Widow of William Ives late of Pictou aforesaid Merchant deceased do hereby make publish and declare this to be my last will and testament hereby revoking all wills at by me any time heretofore made.

I appoint my son George D Ives and Frederick W Fraser Druggist of said Pictou to be the executors and trustees of this my Will

I give devise and bequeath to Maggie Ives wife of my son Charles W Ives the bill of Sale or chattel Mortgage filed in the Registry of Deeds for Pictou County on or about the 16th day of February AD 1884 and made by the said Charles W Ives as Grantor to me as grantee, the money due me thereon, the household furniture and other property therein described or conveyed and I also give to said Maggie Ives all other my household furniture now in her possession or that of her late husband Charles W Ives

I also give devise and bequeath to said Maggie Ives all my case of Silver ware (except the tea Service herein after mentioned) now in her

possession

I give and bequeath to my daughter Emma Harris my writing desk and Silver tea Service

I give and bequeath to Ocenia Ives wife of my son Arthur Ives all my household furniture now in the farm house on the south side of the West River Road wherein they reside

I give and bequeath to Christiana daughter of the said Arthur my share in the Merchant's Bank Halifax Capital Stock now held by me

I give devise and bequeath all my real and personal estate not hereinbefore of unto my said executors and trustees in trust that they may my said executors and trustees shall see call in and convert into money the same or such part thereof as shall not consist of money and shall with and out of the previous produced by such sale calling in and Conversion and with and out of my ready money pay my funeral and Testamentary expenses and

debts and shall stand possessed of the residue or remainder upon the trusts following viz to pay the following legacies

1 To pay my son William H Ives the Sum of one thousand five hundred dollars

2 To pay my son George D Ives the Sum of Six hundred dollars

3 To pay my Grandson Fred Ives son of George D Ives the sum of one hundred dollars

4 To pay Willie and Christiana Ives the children of my son Charles W Ives the Sum of fifty dollars each

5 To pay to Daniel Fraser, Lewis and Louisa children of my son Arthur Ives the Sum of fifty dollars each

6 To pay to Daniel F Harris and Christiana Harris children of my daughter Emma Harris the Sum of fifty dollars each

If any residue and monies be their remaining I will and direct that they shall be equally divided between the respective wives of my son George D Charles W and Arthur Ives and my daughter Emma Harris to each an equal share

It is also my will and hereby expressly declare and direct that the foregoing devises and bequests are respectively intended to be and shall be construed to be in full satisfaction and discharge of any debts or debt which at the time of my death may be owing by me to such respective deviser or legatees or the husband or wife of such respective deviser or legatee whether such legacy or devise shall be less or more in value or amount than the debts owing or claimed

I do will and direct that should any of the legatees under this my will or the husband or wife of such legatees after my death commence any legal proceedings against my executors or estate for the recovery of any alleged just debt that hereupon all legacies and bequests hereinbefore made to such legatee or the husband or wife of the person commencing such proceedings shall lapse determine and become forfeit null and void




Figure 8: William Ives.Invoice.1859.Russel Maclean.Apr.2019




Figure 9: William Ives




Figure 12: George Daniel Ives







"We have already mentioned the children of Dr. HARRIS, and will now speak more especially of the son John W. and his descendants, many of whom are residents of the United States.

In 1811 John Washington HARRIS succeeded his cousin Thomas HARRIS, sr., as Deputy Sheriff [of Pictou], which office he held some years, then was made High Sheriff and continued in office till 1857. At that time his eyesight had become so impaired, presumably from exposure to winter snow and dazzling sunlight, that he resigned in favor of his son William H. [HARRIS], who had been his Deputy. William held the office till his death in 1883, at which time his son George S. [HARRIS] was formally appointed High Sheriff. As his father's deputy he had discharged the active duties of the office, his father's failing eyesight making it impossible for him to them. --- George S. HARRIS was Sheriff but a short time, for in 1885 he, too, passed away, and his only brother, J. Sim HARRIS, was appointed to succeed him. A Pictou paper published some years since said "The Shrievalty in this County

has become hereditary and fixed in the family of HARRIS, and the appointment of any other than one of that name would be passing strange." The present incumbent is the fifth in office, and fifth of that name to occupy an office which has existed in that county one-hundred-and-two years.--- since the year 1791."




Figure 16: Grave Stone


Figure 22: Oceniae Fraser




Figure 29: LRobertsonSr2





Figure 31: Leonard Bowman Robertson






Figure 33: Lewis Zindord Ives




Figure 52: Charlotte H MacDonell




Figure 60: Edna Bell




Figure 63: Norah Louise Robertson

Allan James Robertson was born on Thursday, August 26, 1943, in Pictou, Nova Scotia, Canada. He is the son of James Ives Robertson and Charlotte Helen MacDonell. Allan's Father was born in Stellerton, NS but lived mainly in Pictou, NS. Allan's Mother was born in Judique on Cape Breton Island, NS She mainly grew up there but also later on lived in nearby Port Hood, NS. His paternal ancestors originated from a Scottish immigrant (John Robertson) who received a substantial land grant in the Churchville area of Pictou county, NS. Allan's maternal grandmother out lived three husbands (Allan MacDonell was the second and Father to Allan's Mother) The third husband was James MacDonald and he was the sheriff of Richmond county- Port Hood is the county

seat. James's brother Angus L MacDonald was the premier of NS at one time. He has the Halifax harbour bridge named after him.

Allan's parents met in a place called Catalac, Quebec. They moved to Pictou, NS and then moved briefly to St. Catharines, ON where Allan's sister Lois was born in 1948. They lived in an apartment on Church St near Geneva St. Later that year, the family moved back to Pictou and lived for a brief period in a rented home on Beaches Road - near Laudon's Beach. They then moved to Elm St in Pictou, NS. Later, they moved to 21 Chestnut St - Allan is most familiar with this address as he lived there from grade school until grade 10. Then his parents "swapped" homes with his paternal grand parents who lived 95 Faulkland St - SE corner of Faulkland and Patterson St. The house is still there but the number has changed due a change in the house numbering system. Bea's (nick name for his paternal grandmother) cousin - Margaret Harris (nee Fraser) lived in a home on Patterson St - across from Bea's home. (SW corner of Faulkland and Patterson streets)

The home was actually jointly owned by Bea and her older (unmarried) sister Annie Ives. When Annie died, she willed her half to Allan's Father, When Bea died, Allan's Father got the home but his brother Len and sister Louise received all the fine antique furniture. Allan still has in his possession two mantle decorations that belonged to Bea's Mother - Ocenia Fraser. These pieces may even predate her as there is no record as to where they came from.

Allan's Father worked in the ship yard as a sheet metal worker. He later started his own business from some funding from his brother Len. However it was not entirely successful. They eventually sold the house and moved to a trailer home at 7 Oak St. Allan's Father died in 1989.

Allan's kindergarten year was at the former Patterson school on Wellsford St near Poplar St. Grades 1 and 2 were at Stella Maris Convent. Allan remembers one of his class mates (his last name was Bell) drown after falling of the wharf. The whole class went to the funeral after visiting the remains in the family home. (Grades 3-6 were at the former Dawson school (now gone). Grades 7 and 8 were back at the Patterson school and finally grades 9 to 12 were at Pictou Academy. Allan's grades were "average" up until Grade 11 then in Grade 12, he and one of his friends (Wayne Madore) decided that they would be first in their class. Wayne did graduate 1st but Allan was 2nd. They edged out a girl (Maureen Mullins) who had continually placed first in her class through out her Junior and Senior high school years.

His closest friends while growing up were Wayne Madore and Melton Scanlan - they married two sisters and became teachers. They lived in Green Hill - near Pictou. John Murray who attended Dalhousie University and became a medical doctor. He practised in Sussex NB. Larry McCormack who also addended St Francis University and became a geologist.

In his younger years, Allan was very close to his paternal grandmother (Louisa "Bea" Robertson - nee Ives). He spent a lot of time with her and had a lot of fun playing cards with her. He was her "favourite grand child" - perhaps because he was the first. His

grandmother also lived in St Catharines with him and his parents. Allan would often walk (mostly run) with her to Montebello Park and also visit with a family friends (Browns?) who lived at 56 lake St.

Bea willed him an old family photo album that belonged to her grandfather - William Ives. That photo album along with a booklet on the history of the Robertson family which was updated by his uncle Len Robertson, got Allan very much interested in the family genealogy. The result is this family tree of over 27,000 related persons.

Because of the influence of his high school science teacher (Mr. Peter Whyte), he decided to be a chemist. Mr. Whyte allowed Allan and his friend Wayne to stay after school and "experiment" in the lab - unsupervised!! In hind sight, not a wise thing to do - but they survived with "all of their fingers" still attached.

Both Allan and Wayne enter the bachelors program at St Francis Xavier University in 1961 and took up chemistry as their major. Allan graduated from St Francis Xavier University (BS Hon. in 1965 and received his MSc 1967). Unfortunately, his friend Wayne got hooked on golf in his third year and then dropped out of university. He later took up teaching and did very well.

Allan lived on campus for his under graduate years and then boarded off campus while working on his master's degree. Part of that time he lived with the Ray MacDonald family - Ray was a news announcer at the local radio station (CJFX). The MacDonald's had five children - 4 boys named Mathew, Mark, Luke and John and one daughter - Mary.

His closest friends while at university were Tony McPhee-from Sydney, NS and one of the brightest students who was also a chemistry major. Tony taught Allan how to play chess. Out of hundreds of games, Allan only won once. Bruce Barron - a "pre-med". student from Portland, ME, Marry Osiany - she came from Hungary with her family in 1956 after the Hungarian uprising. Gary McQuade - also his roommate in his junior year. Gary was from Ottawa and was one of the star hockey players with St FX.

During his Freshman year, one of his chemistry lab instructors was a graduate student named "Bud Gallivan" - a nephew to "Danny Gallivan" who was a famous hockey announcer for the Montreal Canadians. Bud went on to Notre Dame University where he obtained his PhD. He then went to work for American Cyanamid at the corporate research lab in Stamford, CT. Bud rose through the ranks and eventually became VP of the division in which Allan worked. Allan's boss at that time was a direct report to Bud and on his boss' passing, Allan reported to Bud for a brief period. Unfortunately, later in the same year, Bud died from a sudden heart attack. It was shortly after that that Allan was transferred from research to marketing. This was a traumatic change for a month or so, but then he thoroughly enjoyed the new position.

While at university, during the summer holidays, Allan worked as a lab technician for the then Cyanamid of Canada in Niagara Falls, ON. He worked at the "Welland Plant". For the first 4 summers, Allan resided with his Aunt and Uncle (Louise and Les Bongard). Louise is Allan's

Father's younger sister. He hung out with his cousin Robert (Robbie). In later years, Robbie moved to Lunenburg, NS with his second wife.

He bought his first car in the summer of 1965 - a 1956 Ford Fairlane - for \$160. Later, he drove it to Nova Scotia that fall and during the following spring, he sold it for \$200 to a local in the Antigonish area.

During the summer of 1965, he resided at 138 Page St. in Catharines, ON. This is when he met his future wife - Virginia Worobel - who lived next door at 136 Page St. Virginia was in a nursing program at St. Joseph's in Toronto. They "dated" - mostly by mail for about 2 years.

After Allan got his MSc degree in January of 1967, he moved back to 138 Page St. and got a permanent job with Cyanamid. Virginia finished her nursing program in 1968.

For the better part of a year during 1968 and Allan was transferred to Cyanamid's Bound Brook NJ site. He boarded at a private home in Summerset, NJ for about 6 months (Mrs. Tureck's home). While there he met a couple of friends who also worked for Cyanamid - Paul Gastrock and George Menghi. Both came to Allan and Virginia's wedding on April 19 of 1969.

After about 6 months, Allan rented an apartment in Raritan, NJ. During this year, he would commute to St Catharines every other weekend.

Then in December of 1968 he moved back to 136 Page St - just in time for a 3 -4 month labour strike at Cyanamid. During that period he was part of the management team that ran the Welland Plant as well as a limestone quarry in Beechville, ON. While at Beechville, he had a half hour training course on how to drive one of those huge trucks used to haul crude limestone from the quarry to the crusher. After 3 weeks of that he was reassigned to the Welland Plant as an operator in the production area - he much preferred this job.

The strike finally ended about a week prior to the wedding on April 19, 1969.. The wedding took place at the St Catharines cathedral with the reception at the Ukrainian Black Sea hall. It was a typical Ukrainian style wedding with approximately 150 guests. Allan's parents as well as his younger siblings, and aunts and uncles from Chatham, New Brunswick and Montreal attended. Virginia also had several relatives from Saskatoon and Winnipeg and Fort Frances, ON also attended.

Virginia's sister and brother-in-law were maid of honour and best man Allan's cousin Robert Bongard and Allan's sister Lois as well as Virginia's cousin and a best friend - Ann Cotnam were also in the wedding party.

After the reception, they stayed over night at Prudholms hotel in Vineland before heading off to Jamaica for a week long honeymoon. They landed in Montego Bay and rented a car. They stayed there for two nights and then toured the Island. Finally flew home from Kingston.

Virginia and Allan lived with her Mom at 136 Page St for about a year - during which Jenny was born on Jan 30, 1970. During the summer of the following year, they moved into a newly built home at 80 Meredith Dr. in St Catharines. Virginia's Mom moved with them. On July

6 of 1971 Adele was born and on August 11 of 1973 Lara was born.

The house on Meredith D.r was starting to get a bit crowded. They then bought their current home at 36 Forster Ave in Thorold for the amazing low price of \$64,000 which likely would sell got \$400,000 today (2018)

Allan spent his working career as a research chemist with Cyanamid of Canada Inc. - which later became Cytec Canada Inc. 1995 Since his retirement in 2013, Cytec was bought by Belgian company called Solvay. For about 40 years, he worked in the lab and then for the last 11 years, he took on a marketing role. Over his career, he obtained 12 patents and either authored or co-authored about 50 scientific papers. He also received a Circle of Excellence Award from the company for scientific achievement. As part of the award, there was a weekend all expenses paid visit to NYC - including a Broadway play and gala dinner with the other award winners and company executives. Stayed at a fancy hotel on Park avenue.

The job - especially in the later years, involved a considerable amount of travel - either to scientific conferences or visiting customers - almost all were outside of Canada - mainly in the US, Europe, South Africa and Australia. At several of the conferences, - those related to phosphorus chemistry- he presented talks. They took place in such places as Duke University in Durham, SC, Tallin, Estonia, Saltzberg, Austria, Jeruslahem, San Francisco and Sundhi, Japan .On some occasions such as the conferences, Virginia came along.

In December of 1995, Cyanamid became Cytec. Allan eventually retired in April of 2013 after 51 years of serving with Cyanamid/Cytec. This was the second longest service term within the company. The company put on a great retirement party with about 70 employees attending. The guests also included the company CEO and well as the corporate HR VP.

At the age of 25, Allan James married **Virginia Worobel** on Saturday, April 19, 1969, in St Catharines, Niagara, Ontario, Canada, when she was 23 years old. They have three daughters.




Figure 67: Allan James Robertson




Figure 68: Allan James Robertson




Figure 70: Allan Robertson's Baptism




Figure 72: Allan James Robertson




Figure 87: Lois Christina Robertson


Figure 88: Lois Robertson Obit




Figure 120: img001214








Figure 133: img001040




Figure 137: Michelle3
