I, William Cunningham of New Glasgow, in the County of Pictou, being of sound mind and memory, but knowing the uncertainty of life, and the certainty of death, do make my last will and Testament in the manner and form following.

1st I give and bequeath the sum of Twenty Dollars unto the Reverend D. B. Blair of Barney's River.

2^d I give and bequeath unto my son John Cunningham One Hundred and Sixty Acres of Land owned by me, said Land being situated at Moose River in the said County of Pictou.

After he the said John Cunningham shall pay or cause to be paid the above bequest to Rev. D. B. Blair and all necessary expenses connected with my burial, said burial to take place at Spring Brook, West River.

3^d I nominate and appoint Hugh Ross, James, and Peter Campbell, Blacksmith, both of said New Glasgow, as Executors of this my Last Will and Testament.
