I Duncan Falconer being infirm  
in bodily health - but of sound disposing  
mind and memory and convinced that  
all have once to die do make this my  
last will and testament

1<sup>st</sup> I devise my body committed to the  
earth dust to dust. My Spirit I  
commit to the God who gave it  
whilst I trust to the mercy of Jesus  
Christ for the remission of sins and  
hope for a glorious resurrection beyond  
death and the grave through him  
who is the resurrection and the life

2. I give devise and bequeath  
unto my beloved wife as Guardian  
of my son until he attains the legal  
age of twenty one years the house  
and premises owned and occupied  
by me together with all the  
personal or moveable property I  
may die possessed of, when my  
son Edmund attains the legal age  
he is to become proprietor

3. I give devise and bequeath  
unto my daughter Wilhelmina that  
portion of land by me between the  
Rivers and the boundaries of lands  
of John Mc Intosh on the South  
side of my property as her portion  
of my estate, the residue of my  
property to become that of my  
beloved son Edmund when he  
attains the age of twenty one

4 I order and charge my son  
Edwin to support and completely  
keep my beloved wife during her  
natural life, provide all necessary food  
and raiment and medical aid if  
required in health and sickness to  
provide to treat her with kindness  
as an affectionate parent and loving  
mother. In the event of the widow-  
hood of my beloved partner I name  
then I desire my son to be  
relieved of making any further  
provision for her

5 I give devise and bequeath  
unto my beloved wife all money  
I die possessed of for her use  
benefit and behalf forever together  
with such household furniture as  
she may require if she occupies  
a separate apartment of the domicile

6 I desire that such part of the  
moveable property as may not be  
required by the family after my  
death be disposed of and the proceeds  
placed in Bank to the credit and  
in the name of my son Edwin.

I hereby appoint my beloved  
wife sole executrix of this my last  
will and testament.
