The thirty first day of August. One thousand eight hundred and eighty one. I Adam Travers of Little Harbour in the County of Pictou, being weak of body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be given unto God. therefore calling unto mind the mortality of the body, knowing that is appointed unto all men once to die, do make and this my last will and testament, that is to say principally and first of all, I give and recommend my soul unto the hands of Almighty God that gave it, and my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in decent Christian burial at the discretion of my executors nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the Almighty power of God. And as touching such worldly goods wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this life I give demise and dispose of the same in the following manner and form.

First, I give and bequeath to Nancy my dearly beloved wife the free right and privilege of all and singular my real and personal estate for her maintenance and support during her life time, viz. said portion of my estate settled and conveyed as follows, on the north by the waters of Little Harbour, on the East by lands of Daniel Mc Donald, on the south by the Highway leading through Little Harbour, and on the west by lands belonging to John Calquhoun, and at her decease to be buried in decent Christian burial at the discretion of my executors hereafter mentioned.

Also, I give and bequeath unto my wife Nancy full power and authority to will and dispose of the same to whom she pleases at her discretion.

Also, I appoint make constitute and ordain George Laurie Esquire to be my executor ratifying and confirming this to be my last will and testament, and no other, whereunto I have set and subscribed my hand and seal this thirty first day of August

(1881) one thousand eight hundred and eighty one.
